MACHAKOS UNIVERSITY HOSTS 4TH NATIONAL ECONOMICS DEBATE: YOUNG ECONOMISTS CHAMPION FAIR AND INCLUSIVE GROWTH

The Machakos University Economics Students Association (MUESA), in partnership with the Kenya Economics Students Association (KESA), hosted the 4th National Economics Debate on Friday, 31st October 2025, at the Machakos University Amphitheatre. Themed “Finding a Fair and Inclusive Economic Structure for All Kenyans,” the debate provided a vibrant platform for students to exchange ideas, challenge perspectives, and propose solutions to Kenya’s pressing economic issues. The event brought together economics students from various universities across Kenya, including Meru, Kimosi, MMUESA, MKU, Kabarak, Embu, CUEA and Maasai Mara fostering collaboration and knowledge-sharing among the next generation of economists.

In her opening remarks, the MUESA Chairperson emphasized the importance of creating inclusive policies that ensure equitable access to economic opportunities across all sectors of society.
