Machakos University has signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Seoul National University of Science and Technology (SeoulTech), marking another milestone in the University's internationalization agenda and its commitment to advancing Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) education through strategic global partnerships.

The MoU was presented during a courtesy call by Mr. Scarlet Min, representing the President of SeoulTech, Prof. Dong Hwan Kim. 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STEPS FOR APPLYING FOR A KUCCPS INTER-INSTITUTION TRANSFER

1

Log in to the KUCCPS Student Portal

- KCSE Index Number, KCSE (User Name)
- Year (Indicate the Year of Your KCSE Exams)
- Password: KCPE Index or Birth Certificate number

2

On the dashboard, select "Transfer Application" to proceed

- On your dashboard, click the Transfer Application tab.

3

Choose Your Preferred Institution and Programme

- Enter the programme code of your preferred course. Ensure you meet the minimum entry requirements, and the remaining details will be generated automatically.

4

Provide a Reason for the Transfer

- Select or enter the reason for requesting the transfer (Options, Choices available)

5

Payment of the Transfer Fee (System Prompts and give payments on e-Citizen)

- Obtain the eCitizen Payment Reference Code and pay processing fee of KES 1,000 on MPESA or Bank

6

Submission of Application

- Your application will then be forwarded to the institution (Receiving Institution) of your choice

7

Track the Application Status

- Monitor the progress of your application through the KUCCPS Student Portal.

8

Receiving Institution Endorsement

- Your preferred institution reviews and endorses the application if you have a vacancy.

9

Current Institution Release

- Your current institution reviews the request and releases you through the KUCCPS portal.

10

KUCCPS Approval

- KUCCPS reviews and approves the transfer after both institutions have acted on the application.

11

Download the Transfer Letter

- Letter of transfer generated by KUCCPS and the Student can download from the portal Basket.

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
